

MCVOAD Minutes
6/27/2006, 4:30-5:30pm

Participants: Sharon Heck – DSV, Vicki Kowal – MRC, Marvena Baker-Shriver – MRC, Jack Frank – DSV, Beth Graham – Risen Lord Lutheran Church, Traci Hales-Vass.

Discussion Items:

- Per Sharon and Jack, the DSV / MRC / MCVOAD booth at Bailey Days was successful. 30 people approached the booth for information. The Files of Life were well received.
- Jack met with Judy Peratt and Greg Mosier regarding the management of spontaneous, uninvited volunteers (SUV's). DSV SUV's can be processed through MRC and Jeffco Sheriff. Future concerns to be addressed will be liability and background checks.
- Regarding self-registry for residents at-risk, Vicki reported that Seniors' Resource Center (SRC), Mt Evans Hospice, and Park County Seniors Coalition have developed and successfully implemented effective procedures to assist at-risk clients during a disaster. Through a conversation with SRC, the case manager decided to develop an official list of at risk people, because the list is currently "in her head." Vicki is waiting for a return call from Apria. Beth reported that Fire Departments are interested in providing a self-registry form through the Sheriff's Departments.
- MCVOAD, MRC and DSV will share a booth at Conifair on Aug 26 and 27. Set-up will be on Friday the 25th. Marvena expressed staffing concerns. It is hoped that MRC will have enough volunteers and staff over the weekend. Vicki will help on Friday and Sunday. Traci will help mid-shift on Saturday. Marvena is "flexible." Jack, Sharon, and Beth will commit to specific times later as the date approaches, but Beth may need to booth sit for her church. Sharon submit app. Cost is \$75. Chamber member NPO's pay \$50 (MRC is a member). It is hoped that a free space will be acquired and this will be requested. A tent and table will also be needed.
- Vicki sent out 40 resource surveys so far in conjunction with a school supplies donation mailing. More surveys will be sent in July.
- MCVOAD participants continue to agree that the phone conference works well for now, resolving transportation and attendance problems.

To Do List:

- **MCVOAD** – get tent, plastic tubs, fliers, and 5 foot table for Conifair.
- **Vicki** – connect with Apria regarding self-registry, medical care, medical supply delivery, and evacuation in the event of a disaster.
- **MCVOAD and MRC** – Update Community Resource surveys through mailer.
